

FISHING AREAS

Boundaries will be all navigable waters on Devils Lake only. All boats will leave the ramp under a single file controlled start beginning with the boat registered #1.

Exception: East Bay Tournament: Boundaries will be all navigable waters on Devils Lake EAST of Hwy 20 ONLY.

ELIGIBILITY

Spring Northern/Walleye, East Bay & DL Open: An eligible fishing team shall be made up of 1-2 or 3 persons. Persons of any age are eligible to enter, but one team member must be at least 18+ years old. All persons must be members of LRAA. **THESE TOURNAMENTS ARE A TEAM OF THE YEAR QUALIFYING EVENT. Teams must be registered at the Spring Northern/Walleye Tournament.**

Adult / Child: An eligible fishing team shall be made up of 2 - 4 persons, however there is a maximum of only one adult angler allowed per each youth angler. Persons of any age are eligible to enter, but one team member must be at least 18+ years old. All persons must be member of LRAA.

Walleye Widow: Eligible fishing teams shall be made up of 1 male & 1 female, or 2 males and 2 females. Persons of any age are eligible to enter but one team member must be at least 18+ years old. All persons must be member of LRAA.

REGULATIONS

All contestants must observe US Coast Guard and NID Game & Fish Dept. rules, regulations, laws & license requirements. Life preservers must be worn when boat is on plane. All teams are responsible for their fish following the outing. Contestants are reminded that the "Spirit of the Rule" will prevail in all judgement cases.

REGISTRATION • ENTRIES • WEIGH-IN PRE-REGISTRATION REQUESTS

Teams must register prior to the outing scheduled time. No late entries will be allowed. Each team will undergo a boat check and be issued a team number. At the weigh-in, one member of the team must deliver their number to the scoreboard, even if the team does not have any fish to weigh. The team may then load out their boat & proceed to weigh-in their catch.

AQUATIC NUISANCE SPECIES INSPECTION

ALL boats must be inspected for ANS prior to doing any fishing, or entry into a LRAA outing. Anglers will be required to sign-off on an ANS questionnaire form during registration prior to fishing in LRAA outings.

SCORING

Team standings shall be determined by a total weight of their chosen 5 northern pike and 5 walleyes. (And 5 white bass for Adult/Child & Walleye Widow Tournament only.) The northern pike must be a minimum length of 20 inches and the walleye must be at least 15 inches. (Exception: The Adult/Child tournament has no limits on size or weight.) The team limit will be a total of 7 walleye and 7 northern pike. Any ties will be determined by the largest walleye. There will be no early weigh-in unless arrangements have been made with tournament directors.
