Here are the results from the Devils Lake Open Fishing Tournament held Saturday June 17th, 2023.

The 19 teams of anglers experienced a fishing day with clear sunny skies, temperatures were in the mid 70's, with calm to light winds out of the South East. The teams found fish at many different depths, shallow, in 12 to 17 feet and on deep structure. Anglers are still casting crank-baits, pitching jigs tipped with plastic, using bobbers and now adding the use of bottom bouncers and spinners to their fishing presentations.

Walleye: - 81 walleye caught @ 190.41 lbs - an average weight of 2.35 lbs. per fish

Northern Pike: - 69 pike caught @ 249.58 lbs = an average weight of 3.62 lbs per fish
